- And a further developer direct contribution to HPC of £42,000 (Hayfield Homes).

Of these funds we have earmarked:

- 1) CIL Glyannis £2, 611.55p to refurbishment of the Scout Hut (agreed MHDC), plus further funds from reserve to take total contribution to £5,000.
- 2) £10,000 to purchase of the allotments from Worcester County Council, to come from CIL and agreed MHDC.
- 3) £10,000 installation of water supply to allotments, likely to come from CIL
- 4) Improvement to or replacement of Sports Pavilion currently obtaining quotes.
- 5) A small grants fund of £5,000 to assist local community organisations on request.

In the light of this level of reserve HPC did not raise the precept in 2021.
